Mission

The Berkshire, Buckinghamshire and Oxfordshire Section supports the national University, College and Research Group (UCR) by providing a focus and a forum for the professional concerns and interests of everyone working in national, research or academic libraries, linking these with current and emerging issues and developments.

Action Plan

Objective 1 To ensure opportunities for individual personal and professional development through involvement in the group's activities

- Action 1: Hold events (seminars, visits, talks, debates etc.) based on current issues, the interests of members and areas of speciality within the region
- Action 2: Actively encourage regional committee membership and participation by young professionals

Objective 2 To engage proactively with national issues and debates, contributing to the formulation of CILIP initiatives and responses, and ensuring appropriate linkages, participation and communication within CILIP

- Action 1: Feed into responses to relevant reports, publications etc as contributed to by national committee
- Action 2: Ensure that a regional representative reports to and attends national committee meetings

Objective 3 To encourage and facilitate the exchange of information and experience with other organisations

- Action 1: Ensure that a full set of events documentation is on the Section's web pages
- Action 2: Ensure communication exchange with CoFHE Mid-West Circle
- Action 3: Continue to hold joint events with CoFHE Mid-West Circle
- Action 4: Ensure communication exchange with BBOD (regional sub-branch of CILIP)
