

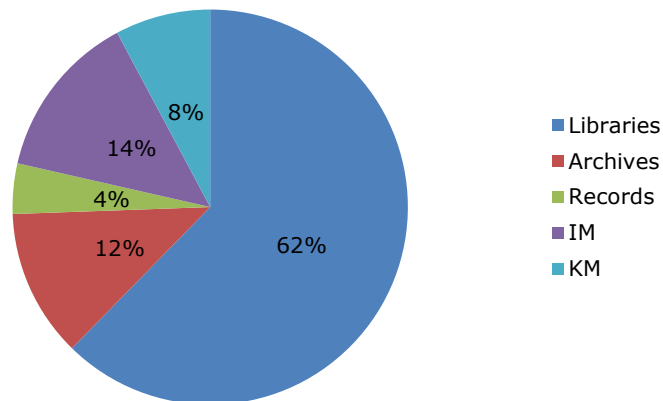
UK Information Workforce - Sector Factsheet: Schools sector

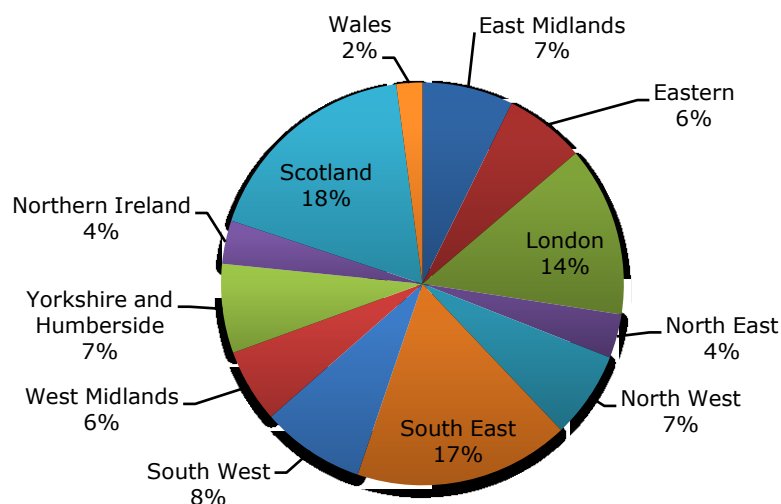
Workforce size, and distribution

There are an estimated 86,376 people working in the entire UK Information Workforce. It is estimated that 8,465 (9.8%) of those work in School settings.

Distribution of sector workforce by domain



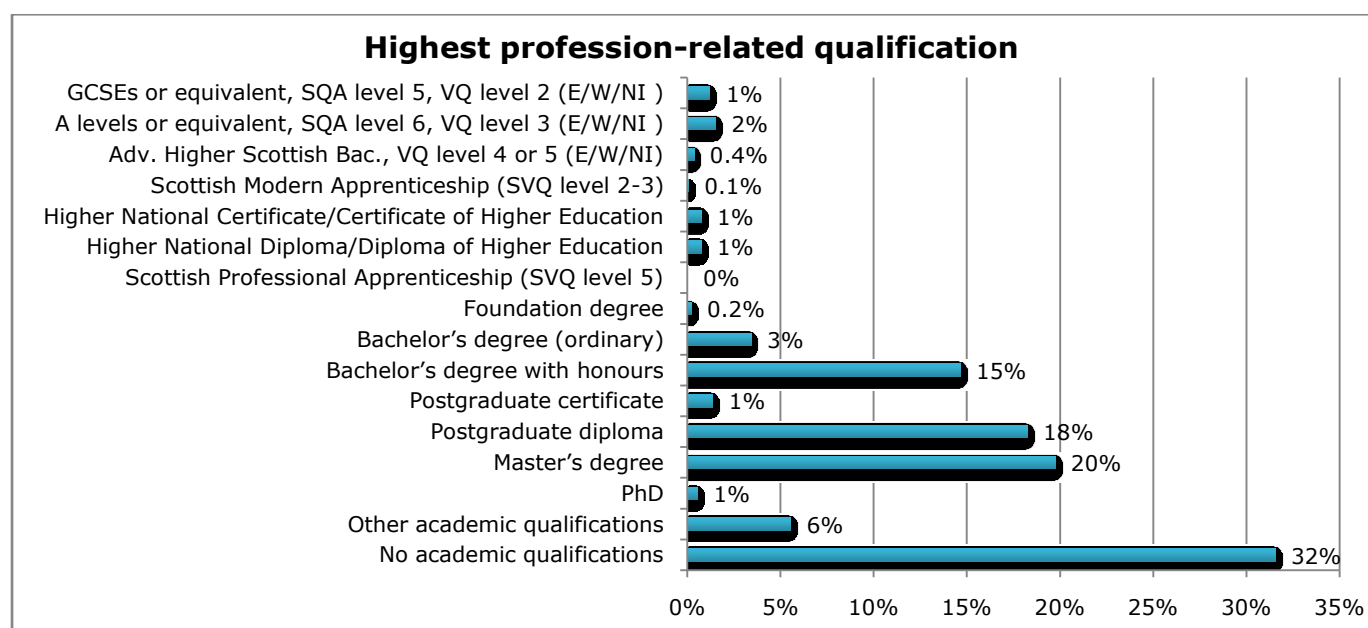
Distribution of sector workforce by region



Workforce diversity

The gender split of those working within the School information workforce is 90% female, 10% male. This compares with a gender split of 78% to 22% within the overall information workforce.
